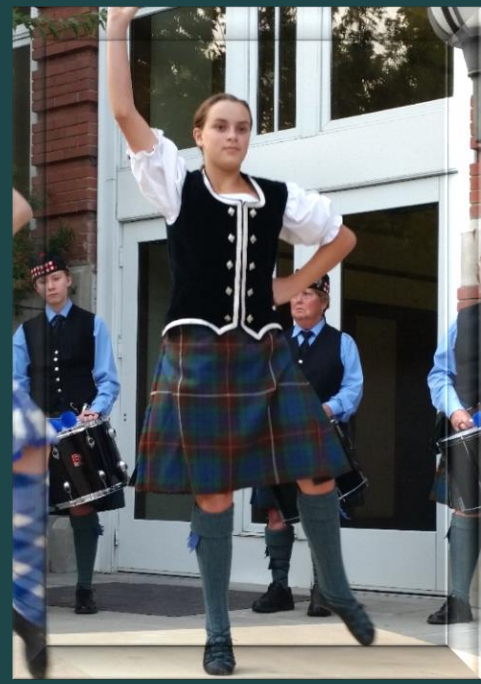
Tourist vs. Traveler

3 ounce or smaller containers of liquid or gel - More than 3 ounces permitted in checked baggage



Container size is a security measure

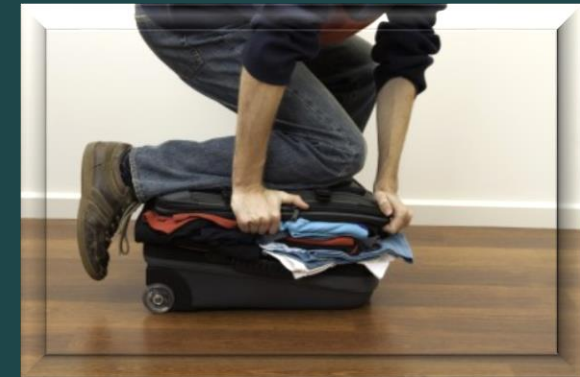
1 quart-size, clear plastic, zip-top bag holding 3 ounce or smaller containers

Bag limits total volume per person



1 bag per traveler placed in the security bin
